Northeast consists of seven states of India, which remain at the extreme northeastern part of India. These states of India are been surrounded by Bangladesh, Bhutan, Burma and China. Ethically the people are Indo-Tibetan in origin. There are around 200 tribal groups speaking 50 languages and 150 dialects. We the Capuchins hae taken up the challenge of working in the Northeast India from 1994. Our missionaries with stand the extreme climates, unfriendly atmosphere, the forest cover which breeds mosquitoes and it in turn to malaria, the art of living with different kinds of tribes and their customs and the fatigue of learning various labguages which are very much in need for the missionaries work in the Northeastern region.

Il Nordest consta di 7 Stati Indiani che si trovano nell'estrema parte nordorientale dell' India. Questi Stati confinano con Bangladesh, Butan, Burma (Birmania) e Cina. Etnicamente le popolazioni hanno un'origine indotibetana. Sono presenti circa 200 gruppi tribali che parlano 50 linguaggi e 150 dialetti. Noi cappuccini abbiamo raccolto la sfida di lavorare nel Nordest dell'India dal 1994. I nostri missionari vivono in climi estremi, in situazioni avverse, in mezzo a foreste piene di zanzare che diffondono la malaria, adattandosi ai diversi modi di vivere delle tribù e affrontando la fatica, assolutamente necessaria per la loro missione, di imparare i vari linguaggi.
